FLOW OF DATA

1. Data gets entered into your Student Information System (SIS)
2. The data is published from your SIS to WISEdata
3. District staff review the WISEdata portal for errors and warnings
4. Data is validated then loaded into WISEdash where the snapshot is taken

As we look to the upcoming DPI Snapshot, on Dec. 7, 2021, our goal at Marcia Brenner Associates is to help our Wisconsin School Districts be prepared with accurate data. This year we will be sending out newsletters with common error codes and their potential resolutions, links to resources, and suggested tips and tricks, all in an effort to help you review your data and ensure its accuracy prior to the snapshot.

So, here's our plan, as an approved vendor we have access to review current error codes in the WISEdata Portal. We cannot see student details just error codes. We will export this information to identify the most common error codes and then share with you the steps to resolve them.

Our goal is to help you be proactive and avoid the stress of inaccurate data.

Now that you understand the plan, we hope you'll take the time to review the information below, share it with other staff members who might also be responsible for reporting state data. Try our suggested resolutions and we'll get to work together getting your data cleaned

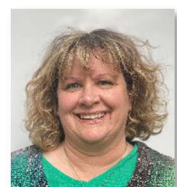

RESOLUTIONS

Below are suggested resolutions to assist you in resolving the associated error code. If this resolution does not resolve your specific issue, we encourage you to submit a Help Ticket through the PowerSchool Community Case Portal.

ERROR CODE	TITLE	RESOLUTION
6381	Required field is missing: Count Date Receiving Services for 3rd Friday	Select the student > State/Province WI – WISEdata Student Information. Populate the Student's Third Friday of September Count Date Status field with "P" or "A" and republish the student's school enrollment record.
6816	School Food Service program association has not been submitted by the school	Select a student > Administration > Lunch. The Start date must match the student's entry date from the current enrollment record. If the status was determined within 30 days of the student's enrollment to the school. If it was determined after 30 days, it is the actual date the status was determined.
6601	Required field is missing: Count Date Receiving Services for Oct. 1 Child Count	Select the student > State/Province WI – WISEdata Student Information. Verify if the student has a published special programs entry or special education download (if using a third-party vendor), that encompasses the Count Date. Lastly, populate the Student's October 1st Count Date Status field and populate with "P" or "A" and republish the student's school enrollment record.
7052	Missing economic disadvantaged characteristics	Select the student > State/Province WI – WISEdata Student Information. Check to see if the student's Economically Disadvantaged Status has been populated with the appropriate codes from the drop-down menu. These fields now populate as either Yes or No.

In addition to errors and warnings in the WISEdata portal your district's Data Exchange may have errors or dependencies that are preventing your data from being published to DPI.

Below are some suggestions on how to make sure the data is even moving from your SIS to DPI.

Tips & Tricks to Resolve Data Exchange Issues

1. Check to see if your Descriptors (state codes) are up-to-date. When was the last activity? If it has been more than a month, we suggest updating them by clicking Run Now.
2. Use the Review button to filter your errors and try to identify the issue. For example, a "Language Descriptor" error means that the appropriate Language code, like "eng" for English was not used. Review the student's Other Info page.
3. If you see an error code 400 or 500 the first step to troubleshoot is to Publish or Retry Errors.

Every night DPI pushes your data from WISEdata to WISEdash. If you review your data in WISEdash and feel it is incorrect back track and review in WISEdata then your SIS.

As a reminder, MBA can assist with the correction and publishing of data from your SIS to WISEdata. We cannot assist with the correction of data between WISEdata and WISEdash.
