2022 WISEDATA CONFERENCE

Mark your calendars for the Department of Public Instruction's (DPI) Annual WISEdata Conference on March 9 & 10. If any part of your job description entails the management of state or federal data for your school district, we encourage you to attend.

The conference mission is to "present attendees with a better understanding of state and federal reporting requirements, including any updates and changes for the 2021-22 school year, as well as provide attendees with information related to new features and functionality in WISE applications."

Please note that CTE reporting will change for the 2021-2022 school year. It will be important for the person(s) responsible for CTE reporting at your district to attend the CTE reporting session(s).

Attendance at this event ensures that your district is receiving current data reporting expectations and best practices.

U.S. Department of Education Civil rights Data Collection (CRDC)

As we shared in our previous newsletter, the Submission System for the 2020–21 CRDC opened on December 13, 2021, to all local educational agencies (LEA) and state educational agencies (SEA). All LEAs have 75 calendar days and must submit their data by the February 28, 2022, close date.

In an effort to assist our districts with the submission of their data we have provided a document that we hope will assist you. TURN YOUR 19-20 PROFILE

In DPI's recent WISEdata January Notification, they noted that on January 25, 2022, the 2019-20 WISEdata API will be turned off.

This means that your district will no longer be able to submit data corresponding to the 19-20 school year after this date.

In order to turn-off the data from submitting you will need to disable the 19-20 profile. Depending on your district's profile is setup please follow the directions below.

1. **"and Later" profile** - From the District Office click on System > Data Exchange > General Setup. Select the "and Later" profile from the drop-down menu and uncheck the box next to 2019-20. Click Save.
2. **WISEdata 2019-20 profile** - From the District Office click on System > System Settings > Plugin Management Configuration > PowerSchool Data Exchange (DEX) > Profile Configuration > Click Edit > Check the Off radial button > Click Save.

22-23 NON-BINARY GENDER CODE







DPI recently made the announcement that with the 22-23 school year, districts can report a student's gender as non-binary.

We have received several support cases regarding how to do this so we wanted to share the directions with all of you. Please note that you may want to discuss with other third-party vendors how this will affect the publishing of this data.

Please note, these directions will simply update the available gender options on your demographics page. This information will not report to DPI until the 22-23 school year.

To update your gender options, from the District Office, under Setup click on District > select the Gender Code Set from the drop-down menu > Click the Add Code button > fill in the fields and click Submit.
