## WIR IMMUNIZATION INTEGRATION

As many of you are aware, we continue to experience issues in regards to the Wisconsin Immunization Registry (WIR) Integration with PowerSchool.

We are currently awaiting PSSR-284917 to tentatively be resolved with the April State Reporting release. This ticket will update the school year that the immunization request looks at.

Additionally, PSSR - 269509, which is related to COVID vaccines is tentatively going to be included with the March state reporting release. We appreciate your continued patience as our teams work to resolve these issues.

PSSR - 262665, Update/Remove CWCS, SCED version number and CWCS Course code are removed from Course Setup page.

PSSR-269974 CTE Updates, the following updates are in preparation for assisting districts with where/how to enter the data. Please note that additional updates are still needed by EDFi to deliver the data appropriately to DPI.

- Sections, on the Sections Setup pg., Certificated/Non-Certificated Career Education Program is now a multi-select field for the 21-22 and beyond. 20-21 and prior years, the select list will only allow 1 Certificated/Non-Certificated Career Education Program to be selected.
- On the Sections Sections Setup pg., the Certificated/Non-Certificated Career Education programs are updated for the 21-22 and beyond. For 20-21 and prior years, the previous list of programs will display.
- On the Students CTE page, the Non-Certified Career Education Program list for 21-22 is updated. The new list will display for 21-22 and beyond. For 20-21 and prior, the previous list of programs will display.
- On the Students Edit All Enrollments page, Certificated/Non-Certificated Career Education Program field is now multi-select.
- On the Historical Grades page, the following fields are removed for the 21-22 and beyond school years.  
Certificated Programs Status Type, Certificated/Non-Certificated Career Education Program from Section.  
These fields will display for 20-21 and prior school years.

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### ! KNOWN ISSUE

\*Our State Reporting Team is aware of an issue in regards to the reporting of courses with an identification in the Dual Enrollment and/or World Language fields. These fields have now been changed to multi-select and are not yet coded to properly report to the WISEdata portal. This issue has PSSR-285298 assigned to it and is tentatively due to be resolved with the April State Reporting Release.

WORK PLAN**





## CTE DATA PREP BEFORE END-OF-YEAR

Keeping your CTE (Career & Technical Education) data current and ready for the snapshot has never been more important. At the recent DPI Conference, upcoming changes were discussed as to how your district's CTE data is reported. In order to help districts prepare for these changes, we wanted to share some suggestions that districts can do, at the end of the year, to wrap up their 21-22 CTE data.



1. Run & Review the CTE Report in PowerSchool, from your High School>System Reports>State Reporting>CTE Student Profile Report.
2. In the WISEDATA Portal, review the CTE Concentrator Export.
3. Review Organization Schedules in your current year's Data Exchange profile to ensure that all CTE Courses have an appropriate SCED or Roster code. Click [here](#) for a listing of current course codes. These can be filtered to show CTE Courses and Pathways.
4. Before summer break, enter a program status for each CTE student. State/Province-WI>Career Technical Education (CTE).
