FOR 2022-23 SCHOOL YEAR

As part of our role in supporting our Wisconsin clients with state reporting data, we want to share with you some new and updated data elements for the 2022-23 school year. Below is a list of items that will be added or changed with upcoming state reporting releases.

Preferred Gender - DPI will now accept the reporting of a Non-Binary gender option, reported as "X". Warning 6393, will be issued when gender in WISEdata doesn't match.

Exit Type Updates - "PCC" Prior Completion Credential becoming obsolete and "CE" Compassion Exit added.

Student Learning Modality - New required data element. Will be located on new page, District > Setup > Schools/School Info > Other Info > Learning Preference (Public Schools Only) In-Person, Hybrid, Remote. Individual Student option available which will override school default, State/Province-WI > Student Learning Modality.

Info will display at the bottom of the WISEdata Student Info pg. If no records display they will be indicated with the school's default setting.

World Language Program - codes will change per DPI specifications.

Lunch page - Adding new "Explain" link next to the Lunch Status that explains how Food Services Eligibility is published to WISEdata.

Tribal Affiliation - DPI to only allow one Tribal Affiliation. Three will display on the page and PowerSchool will publish Affiliation 1. Only affects districts who are using the enhanced reporting ethnicity option.

SCED Code Update - Per DPI, Districts will use SCED 9 beginning in the 22-23 school year.
